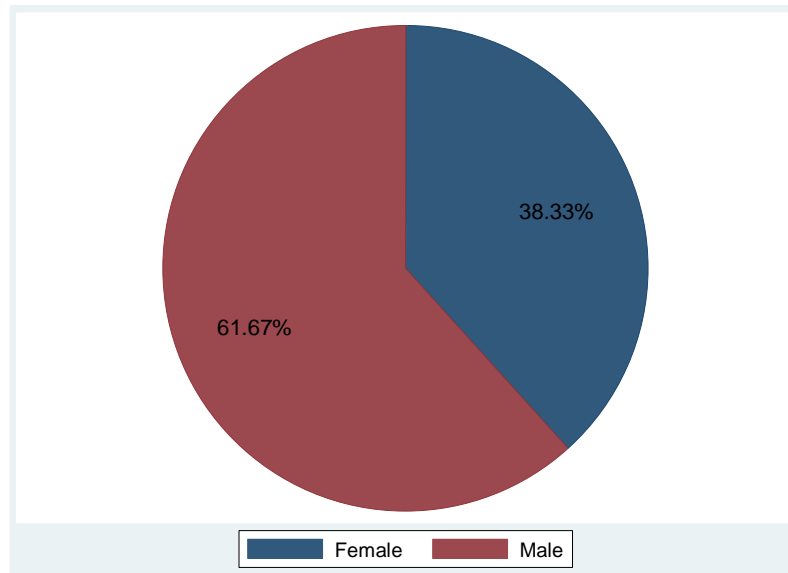

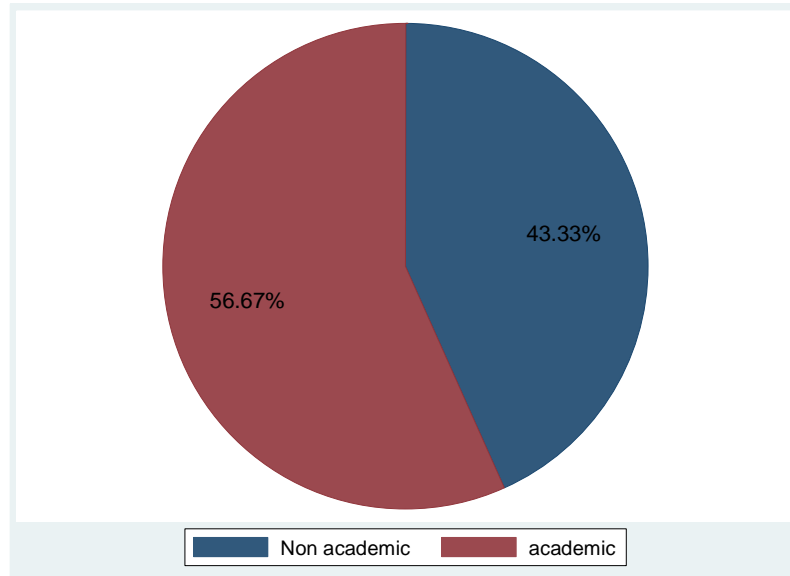
Nearly 62 percent of the members of the PENNY Contact Database are male.
